March 13th/20th/27th— Saturdays— beginners leadlight—construct a small panel - suited to those with no previous experience - with professional leadlighter Steve Nick

March 18th/25th— Thursday evenings—beginners kiln forming—design/cut / fuse/slump —300 x300 platter suited to those with no previous experience—with Glasscraft regular Marina Villani

April/May— Thursday evenings—tiffany lampshade—Ross Lynch will take us through this specialist course—one we are very excited to be hosting—suited to those who have some experience in leadlight or copperfoil techniques a commitment of 7 weeks in class over 2 months.. April 29th— Thursday evening—3 hour dichroic pendant class— just in time for mothers day!

August 7th/14th/21st/28th— Saturdays—glass casting—with Ruth Mc Callum-Howell we are very excited to have Ruth with us - Ruth's work has been exhibited many times at major glass galleries

September 18th/25th— Saturdays— beginners bead making—with Kathryn Wardill—if you couldn't make the first class in June this may be a better date for you!

October—2nd/9th/16th— Saturdays—beginners leadlight—Steve returns for those who may have missed the first class .. Suited to those with no previous experience.

October 7th/14th— Thursday evenings—kiln formed home wares— Marina returns to take you through some interesting ideas for kiln worked home ware designs

October—23rd/30th— Saturdays—intermediate bead making—for those who have completed the beginners course—this class with Kathryn is a feast of exciting techniques

November—we will hold Copperfoil and kiln formed Christmas ornament classes.. And perhaps a last minute dichro pendant class (for those unique jewellery pieces—which make fantastic gifts) Dates to be confirmed—but both will require some experience in glass cutting (in the case of copper foiling—min experience in the field would be an advantage!
